RELEASE OF 2022 SINGAPORE-CAMBRIDGE GCE A-LEVEL EXAMINATION RESULTS

1. The release of the 2022 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 17 February 2023 (Friday) at 2.30 pm.
2. Please read the following information which will detail how you will be receiving your results.

Collection of Examination Results

3. If you are well, you may collect your results slip, certificates and college annual (if applicable) in college from 2.30 pm on 17 February 2023. You may enter the college from 1.00 pm and register your attendance via the Facial Recognition System (FRS). Do note that accompanying parents/relatives/guardians must register at the guard post.
4. Please report to the hall by 2.15 pm for the principal's address and other administrative announcements. Alternatively, you can also access your results online if you are unable to come to the college.
5. If you are unwell, please do not come to the college. You can access your results online via SEAB Candidates Portal at www.seab.gov.sg from 3.15 pm on Friday, 17 February 2023 till 11.59 pm on Friday, 3 March 2023. School candidates who are eligible for Singpass can use their Singpass account to access SEAB's Candidates Portal. School candidates who are international students will receive their system-generated username via email from today, 14 February 2023.
6. For those who are unable to come to the college to collect your results slip and who intend to authorise a proxy to collect your results slip on your behalf, please note that he/she can only collect the results slip with a duly completed and signed **Authorisation Form** which can be found in the attachment. Your proxy will have to bring along this form, as well as his/her **identification card** for verification purposes.

Digital Certificate for Application to Local Autonomous Universities

7. Applications for admissions and/or scholarships to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) can be done online. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online **do not need** to submit a copy of their A-Level certificates. More information on the AU's admissions processes can be found on their respective websites and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.
